ABOUT THE TOOLS OF THE TRADE SCHOLARSHIP

Ascendium doesn't want the cost of tools, clothing, equipment, or other expenses incurred as an apprentice to stop you from reaching your career goals. It's why we're offering \$2,000 scholarships to eligible construction and industrial trade apprentices enrolled in one of the 16 colleges in the Wisconsin Technical College System.

HOW TO APPLY

Complete an application online at **TOTTscholarshipapplication.com**.

You are eligible to apply if:

- You are enrolled in and receiving credit from one of the 16 Wisconsin Technical College System colleges for both Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 semesters. Apprentices who graduate or complete their program in Fall 2025 are not eligible.
- You are enrolled in an eligible construction or industrial trade program (see a list of eligible trades on the application).
- Your combined household income is less than or equal to three times the federal poverty level (the application
 will calculate this based on information you provide about your household income and the number of people
 in your household).
- · You submit a completed application online by November 21, 2025.

We'll send all communication regarding your application to the college-issued email address you provide in your application. We will communicate with your college to confirm your Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 enrollment, which is required to be eligible for this scholarship.

If the number of eligible applicants is greater than the number of available scholarships, we will use a random drawing as a fair mechanism to determine who receives an award among eligible applicants. We will notify apprentices of award status in February 2026 and will mail checks to scholarship recipients at the address you provide in the application.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE EVALUATION INFORMED CONSENT

Ascendium Education Group (Ascendium) has partnered with researchers from Mathematica in Princeton, NJ to conduct an evaluation of the Tools of the Trade (TOTT) scholarship. The evaluation will answer important questions about what types of learners apply for and receive the scholarship and how well the scholarship supports learners in their apprenticeship journey. The evaluation will include all eligible TOTT scholarship applicants who consent to participate in the study, even if they do not receive a scholarship.

WHAT IS THE NATURE OF THE EVALUATION?

The evaluation seeks to understand the extent to which the TOTT scholarship improves a variety of outcomes for apprentices, including things like completion of apprenticeship program and apprentices' future labor market outcomes.

To address this question, the evaluation will compare outcomes for apprentices receiving the scholarship to those who do not receive the scholarship. Ascendium has committed to providing approximately 800 scholarships for this scholarship year. If the number of eligible applicants is larger than the number of available scholarships, a random drawing will be used to determine who receives a scholarship among eligible applicants. The random drawing is administered by a computer and works like a flip of a coin–assignment to a group is random. All applicants who are deemed eligible for the scholarship based on the application process will be included in the random drawing, regardless of whether they decide to opt out of the evaluation after submitting their application.





WHAT INFORMATION WILL BE COLLECTED ABOUT ME?

If you agree to be part of the evaluation, it means you are giving permission for Ascendium, Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS), and your college to share information about you with the researchers for the research purpose described above and only for that purpose. Researchers will take all necessary precautions to protect the privacy of your individual information. In all evaluation analyses, researchers will combine your information with that of others in order to understand the impacts of the scholarship program on apprentices as a whole. Your demographic information and information about your progress in your apprenticeship program will be used to understand the extent to which apprentices, including groups of apprentices who have different characteristics, may benefit from the scholarship. Your social security number and contact information such as your name and email address will be used to match your data across datasets from the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development, including but not limited to unemployment insurance datasets, and records from the WTCS colleges. By signing this consent, I am authorizing the Division of Unemployment Insurance to release to Mathematica the complete record of my unemployment insurance wage earnings and new hire data on my record. This authorization expires 10 years after the date signed. The information from these databases on your employment and earnings and participation in apprenticeships will help the researchers understand the extent to which the scholarship may positively impact apprentices' future career paths. The researchers may request the information listed through the end of the research study.

Within the study period, the researchers may contact you to request that you complete a voluntary, online survey about your apprenticeship experience and your future economic well-being.

HOW WILL MY PRIVACY BE PROTECTED?

All information collected for the evaluation will be kept private to the fullest extent of the law and used for research purposes only. All data will be kept secure, and the researchers will not share your individual data with entities that do not already collect or have access to your individual data, including Ascendium, your college, state or federal officials, or anyone else outside of the research team. Your name and other personal information will never be used in any reports or other products made public through this evaluation. Instead, information about you will be combined with information about other people in the evaluation, so researchers can describe the overall effects of the TOTT scholarship on apprenticeship journeys and participants' experiences.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF PARTICIPATING IN THE EVALUATION?

You will not benefit personally from participating in this evaluation, but your participation in the evaluation could help improve the scholarship program in the future for other apprentices like you. The primary purpose of this evaluation is to understand the benefits of the scholarship and to improve the scholarship and how it is administered to maximize benefits for apprentices.

There are very minimal risks associated with participating in the evaluation. Although researchers will take many steps to protect all information collected as part of the evaluation, there is a very small risk that non-researchers could see it. The survey that will be administered in the future is voluntary, and you can skip or refuse to answer any survey question.





WILL I RECEIVE ANYTHING FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE EVALUATION?

You will not receive a token of appreciation today, but you will receive a \$5 electronic gift card pre-incentive and a \$20 electronic gift card for completing a voluntary survey that may be sent in future.

HOW CAN I WITHDRAW FROM THE EVALUATION?

By submitting your application, you are agreeing to participate in the evaluation. While we hope you will want to continue participating in the evaluation after applying for your scholarship, your continued participation in the evaluation is voluntary. Withdrawing from the evaluation will not affect your chances of receiving a scholarship. You are eligible to receive a TOTT scholarship even if you withdraw from the evaluation, and if you are awarded a scholarship and then withdraw, you can still receive it. We plan to ask Wisconsin Technical College System, your college, and federal and state agency databases for information beginning in 2025. While you can withdraw from the evaluation at any time, if you drop out of the evaluation after any of this data is collected, you are authorizing researchers to use information that was collected about you before you dropped out.
